All parents receive frequent emails so please ensure you have registered your email address with us.

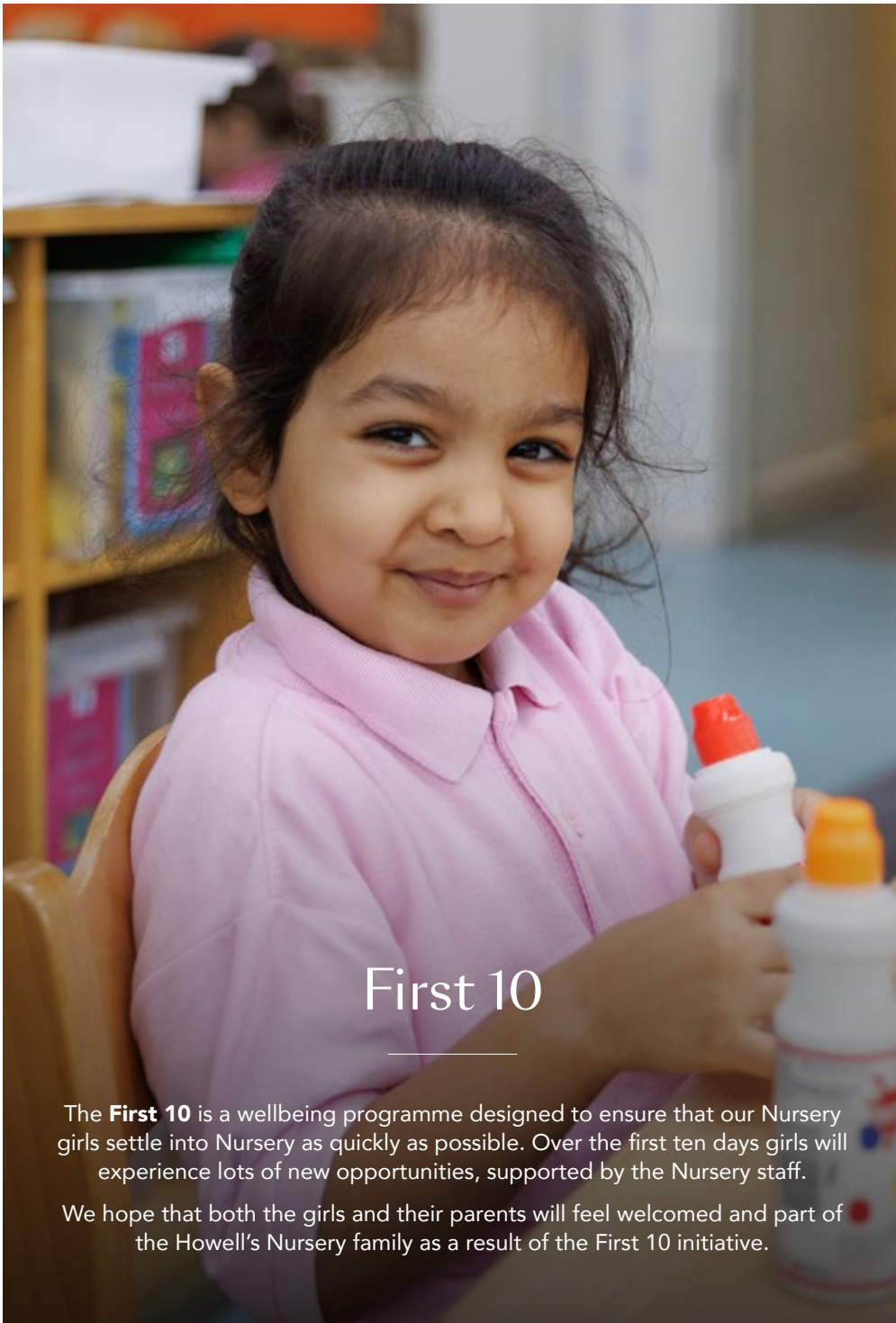

What will your daughter do to help her feel happy at school?

What Will Your Daughter Need At School?

Please label all items brought to school.

To leave at school:

- Raincoat.
- Wellington boots.
- Spare clothes (named)
 - small rucksack to be left on her peg in school to include 2 pairs of leggings, 2 tops, 2 pairs of pants, 2 pairs of socks.

- Slippers (optional)
- School cap and sun cream (summer months).
- We will provide a daily snack and milk or water. The girls have access to drinking water throughout the day.





Physical Education and Woodland Explorers

Your daughter can come to school wearing her PE kit on days in which they have these activities:



Woodland Explorers

All-in-one waterproof suits are provided.

Our beautiful school grounds provide the perfect opportunity to ensure that we can harness your daughter's natural wonder and eagerness to explore and understand her world. Woodland Explorers, our forest school themed group activity, will give her the chance to explore the wonders of the forest as she builds dens, creates trails, forages for mini beasts, and paints with mud, thus inspiring a love for the natural world.



PE and Swimming

- Swimming costume, swimming cap, goggles and a named towel. We provide all swimming aids.
- Polo shirt

Your daughter will have two PE sessions and one swimming lesson a week which will be led by our specialist PE teachers. The aim is to develop her coordination, balance and ball skills. The PE sessions will include gymnastics, dance, games athletics and swimming.

Lunchtime

We offer a balanced menu in the Prep School. This means that we only use brown bread, rice and pasta. Meals are carefully monitored for their nutritional value. All meals are eaten in our Prep School Hall with staff, to ensure that everyone has had a fulfilling meal.



Please let us know if your daughter has any dietary requirements or allergies.

Cookery

We have weekly cookery sessions in Nursery. This allows the girls to explore scientific and mathematical themes as well as thinking about recycling and Fairtrade.

Our Birthday Circle

When it is your daughter's birthday you are invited to celebrate with us in Nursery around her birthday circle. Please bring in an item from when she was 1, 2, and 3 years old. The girls really do enjoy this time and especially having a family member come in to celebrate with them. We usually hold this session in the morning 9:15am - 9:30am or in the afternoon 2:45pm - 3:00pm. Please talk to a member of staff to discuss a suitable time for you.

Our Creative Curriculum embraces elements of the Foundation Phase giving your daughter her all-important introduction to the learning environment. We have developed and established a curriculum that is broad and challenging, but one that will also be tailored to your daughter's individual needs. This enables us to maximize your daughter's learning potential. Child-led and adult-led activities include 'play' activities, which are the central learning tool. She will have real hands-on experiences with sand, water, modelling materials, arts and crafts, mark-making, books, games and puzzles. These will stimulate her ideas, increase her

awareness of shape and space, develop her powers of communication and help her to learn how to work effectively with others.
